This 48-hour course (8-hour Awareness, (fulfills the prerequisite requirement), 40-hour Operations), is designed to provide the First Responder with understanding of and the skills necessary to detect the presence of hazardous materials, identify the hazards associated with these materials, and to take defensive action against these materials. This course is for people who respond to releases of hazardous materials as part of the initial response for the purpose of protecting nearby persons, property, or the environment. This course will prepare the student to take the IFSAC HazMat Awareness/Operations written and practical tests. IFSAC testing will **NOT** be offered during this class. We are trying to schedule the IFSAC Testing for a later date.

Upon completion of this class, the student will:

- Demonstrate a knowledge of the basic hazard and risk assessment techniques
- Demonstrate the ability to select and use proper personal protective equipment
- Demonstrate knowledge of basic hazardous materials terminology
- Perform basic control, containment and/or confinement operations
- Demonstrate implementation of basic decontamination set up and procedures
- Demonstrate knowledge of the relevant standard operating and termination procedures
- Demonstrate knowledge of Weapons of Mass Destruction and how to detect their use
